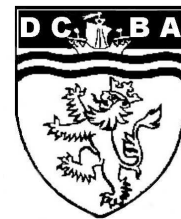

## SENIOR TRIALS 2010/11 SEASON

Applications are invited to form a "County selection committee" with a view to selection of the County 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> teams.

As a County Senior Team selector, it will be necessary to attend the County Restricted on Friday evening 24<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> September and the Senior Trials on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> September i.e. to be available for all 3 events.

Following these events, the County selectors will meet, together with the County Chair and Secretary, immediately following the trials to decide the 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> teams, including reserves.

In order to demonstrate openness and transparency, the County board is looking for 3 selectors who meet the following criteria :-

- Knowledge of County players
- Some knowledge of the process of Team selection
- Where possible the selection committee shall have male and female representation and consist of three selectors, plus the Chair and secretary.
- Where there is a conflict of interest, selectors will be asked to declare such interest to the other selectors and stand down from any discussion involving the conflict of interest.
